

“LITERATURE” PROJECT (2° BACH)

You have to work in groups of 2-3 students in order to make an oral presentation of maximum 5 minutes about a British/American/Irish author.

PROCESS:

- Look for 1 or 2 classmates to work with.
- Choose two or three authors from the list underneath or any other that you know.
- Talk to your teacher about your choices and together decide which one you will work with.
- Look for information about this author and select just the most important facts of his/her life and main works, the historical background and his/her literary relevance.
- Create some visual aid (for ex., powerpoint -max. 5 slides-).
- Scan the first page of one of his/her books in order to read some paragraphs in class explaining 4-5 words or expressions that you may find difficult or interesting to highlight.

EVALUATION:

- You'll get a group mark for the part “Class work” (20% of evaluation mark)
- There will be 1 or 2 questions in the final evaluation test about this project
