ONLINE SHOPPING: THE FUTURE?

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Many popular shops have websites that offer online shopping. How does it work?

1. Go to the website you want to buy from.
2. Find the item you want and click on 'add to basket'.
3. Check that the website address starts https (not http) – this means it's a secure website.
4. Enter your credit or debit card details and that's it!
5. If there's a problem with your order you can return it and get a refund.
